

High School Scholarship Application

The Enlisted Spouses' Club (ESC) at Fort Campbell will award scholarships to Family members of active-duty, retired, or deceased military personnel of all ranks. The applicant is to be enrolled or plan to enroll in college (undergraduate or post-graduate study) or vocational school. The sponsor of the applicant must live within 40 miles of Fort Campbell. Applicants whose sponsors are on unaccompanied tours may, on a case-by-case basis, be granted a waiver of the 40-mile requirement.

Scholarships will be based on academic achievement, personal achievement, and community involvement; not financial need. They may be used for tuition and other academic expenses.

Eligibility Requirements and Procedures

1. TO BE ELIGIBLE, APPLICANT MUST HOLD A CURRENT MILITARY FAMILY MEMBER ID CARD.
2. The applicant must be a high-school senior who will complete requirements for graduation between January and June 2010.
3. The applicant is to attend college or vocational school during the academic year 2010-2011.
4. Awarded funds will be sent directly to recipients' school of choice to an account established in their name.
5. Attach an official sealed transcript of your grades cover the first seven semesters of high school. Include your ACT or SAT and Achievement test scores.
6. Two Scholarship Character references (use attached form only) must be included with the application. One of the references should be from one of your high-school teachers, and the other should be from a person of your choice, not related to you.
7. Completed application packets must be **postmarked no later than April 15, 2010** and mailed to:

8. Do not put your name on pages 2-4 or on the essay pages.
9. Incomplete applications will not be considered. It is applicant's responsibility to ensure packet is complete and on time. To be notified that your application was received, please include a stamped, self-addressed postcard, which will be mailed within two weeks of receipt of the application.
